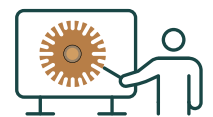


SFJ Awards Lv3 – Award in CHSM Fire Sprinkler Systems

This level 3 Award in Commissioning, Handover, Servicing & Maintaining Fire Sprinkler Systems – Residential and Domestic, (CHSM) course covers all areas of UK legislation and best practice for supervisor level activities of commissioning, handover, servicing and maintenance of residential and domestic fire sprinkler systems.

This course will compliment your current understanding and knowledge that you use in your daily activities – ensuring that supervisors can all work to the latest level of understanding.



AREAS COVERED

- Understanding UK legislation & standards and how these apply to residential and commercial sprinkler systems.
- Understanding regulations covering building undertaker, water and electrical suppliers and how to conduct research and keep up to date with developments and improvements within the residential fire sprinkler industry.
- Understand the theory required for commissioning, handover, servicing, and maintaining residential fire sprinkler systems (CHSM).
- Understand & demonstrate practical elements required for CHSM
- Identifying the required equipment for CHSM.
- Understand the process and protocols required for CHSM. Including resolution of issues.
- Completion of documentation required for CHSM, including checking compliance with building control regulations and the designs.

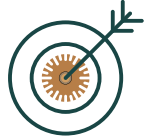

SFJ Awards Lv3 – Award in CHSM Fire Sprinkler Systems



WHO IS IT AIMED AT?

This qualification is a supervisor level course. It has been designed on the basis that candidates must be working in the role of a supervisor in the fire sprinkler industry, looking for a qualification to confirm their knowledge and understanding of UK legislation and best working practice.

This qualification is accepted by JIB as demonstration of proficiency in Supervisor level activities for part of your application for the Fire Sprinkler Supervisor Card.



PREREQUISITES

- Must hold valid CSCS card.
- Be over 18 years old.
- Be able to demonstrate that they are working as a supervisor in the residential fire sprinkler installation industry. To demonstrate this, your employer will be asked to sign an agreement to confirm your suitability of this course for your role, confirming that you work as a supervisor level with the Residential Fire Sprinkler industry.
- Workplace Mentor – your employer will also be asked to agree to assign a Workplace Mentor to support in your learning and practical understanding. The Workplace mentor will also be required to complete a witness statement to formally evidence your learning.
- You must be able to provide evidence of relevant industry qualifications to be accepted for entry to this course. Agreed qualifications:
 - RSA Certificate (2019-2023)
 - SFJ Awards Lv2 Certificate in fire Sprinkler installation 601/6460/8
 - SFJ Awards Lv2 Certificate in fire Sprinkler installation (Residential & Domestic) 610/3701/1
 - ABBE Lv2 Certificate in fire Sprinkler installation 610/4225/0

OR

Provide evidence of experience which is equivalent to the above qualification. A short Teams interview with an RSA staff member may be required to check an applicant's suitability for the course.
